

If any family members /household members develop symptoms of Covid – 19 or have a positive Lateral Flow test please follow the guidance below and inform the school immediately.

- Arrange for a PCR test to confirm whether you are positive for Covid.

Until the PCR test result has been confirmed you may continue to attend school but you must wear a face covering and maintain social distancing as much as possible within the school site.

## Positive PCR Result

- Follow NHS Test and trace service guidelines and immediately self isolate if required to do so by them.
- Tell people you've been in close contact with in the past 48 hrs that you have Covid - 19

## Negative Result

- Continue to attend school as usual.

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## What to do if a Family Member / Household member test positive

- If a family member develops symptoms of Covid – 19 or has a positive Lateral Flow Test please advise the school immediately and arrange for a PCR Test following the advice above.
- If you are subsequently advised by NHS Test and Trace that you will need to self isolate, please advise the school as soon as possible.
- **If you are not required to isolate, the school would ask that your child takes a Lateral Flow Test Daily for 10 days (or each day during your family members isolation period) prior to coming to school each day**
- You should follow advice on [how to avoid catching and spreading COVID-19](#).

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## When you do not need to self isolate

If someone you live with has symptoms of Covid-19 or has tested positive for Covid-19, you will not need to self isolate if any of the following apply:

- You are fully vaccinated – this means 14 days have passed since your final dose of a Covid Vaccine given by the NHS
- You are under 18 years, 6 months old
- You have taken part in a Covid-19 vaccine trial
- You are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons.

Even if you do not have symptoms, you should still get a PCR test to check if you have Covid-19,

Follow the advice on how to avoid catching a spreading Covid-19 and consider limiting contact with people who are at higher risk from Covid -19
