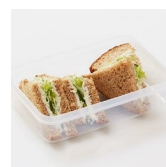
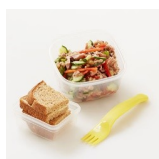
HEALTHY LUNCH BOXES

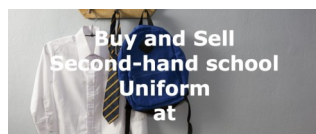
