School Uniform Policy



1 Introduction

- 1.1 It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside normal school hours. We provide a complete list of the items needed for school uniform in our school prospectus.

2 Aims and objectives

- 2.1 Our policy on school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:
- promotes a sense of pride in the school;
 - engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
 - is practical and smart;
 - identifies the children with the school;
 - prevents children from coming to school in fashion clothes that could be distracting in class;
 - makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
 - is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money by most parents;
 - is designed with health and safety in mind
 - follows Government Statutory Guidance regarding cost of school uniforms published 19 November 2021.

3 Jewellery

- 3.1 On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The exceptions to this rule are ear-ring studs in pierced ears. We ask the children to either remove these objects during PE and games, or cover them with a plaster, to prevent them from causing injury. Watches may be worn by children in Years 5 and 6 but they must take personal responsibility for them. Earrings must be removed for swimming lessons.

4 Hair Styles

- 4.1 The school does not permit children to have 'extreme' haircuts or hair colours that could serve as a distraction to other children.
- 4.2 All children with long hair must wear it tied back for health and safety purposes.

5 Footwear

- 5.1 The school wants all children to grow into healthy adults. We believe that it is dangerous for children to wear shoes that have platform soles or high heels, so we do not allow children to wear such shoes in our school. Neither do we allow children to wear trainers to school; this is because we think that this footwear is appropriate for sport or for leisurewear, but is not in keeping with the smart

appearance of a school uniform. We require all children to wear shoes as stated in the uniform list.

6 The role of Parents

- 6.1 We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy. We believe that parents have a duty to send their children to school correctly dressed and ready for their daily schoolwork. One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair.
- 6.2 If any parent would like the school to modify the uniform policy, they should make representation, in the first instance, to the Headteacher.

7 The role of Governors

- 7.1 The governing body supports the Headteacher in implementing the school uniform policy. It considers all representations from parents regarding the uniform policy and liaises with the Headteacher to ensure that the policy is implemented fairly and with sensitivity.
- 7.2 It is the governors' responsibility to ensure that the school uniform meets all regulations concerning equal opportunities.
- Governors ensure that the school uniform policy helps children to dress sensibly, in clothing that is hardwearing, safe and practical and follows Government Statutory Guidance regarding cost of school uniforms published 19 November 2021.

8 Monitoring and review

- 8.1 The governing body monitors and reviews the school uniform policy through its committee work by:
- seeking the views of parents, to ensure that they agree with and support the policy;
 - considering, with the Headteacher, any requests from parents for individual children to have special dispensation with regard to school uniform;
 - offers up to £50.00 of school uniform items to students eligible for Free School Meals;
 - requiring the Headteacher to report to the governors on the way the school uniform policy is implemented
 - ensuring branded statutory uniform items are kept to a minimum
 - providing an outlet for parents to purchase second hand uniform.
